

B Harimava Bridge

This bridge originated as a private access to link wealthy merchants who were situated facing each other across the river during the period of domain duties. The red, varnished arched bridge is a recommended site for taking photographs. The mechanical clock installed at the east side of the bride is also an interesting feature

C Chikurin-ji Temple

The 31st temple of the 88 temples of the Shikoku Pilgrimage. The main hall of the temple was designated as a governmental important cultural asset, known as the temple of learning. The old architecture and garden, including the Daishi hall and 5-story pagoda are also designated by the government as a location of scenic beauty.

H Statue of Sakamoto Ryoma

Ryoma Sakamoto was a man of noble ideals at the end of the Edo period. He was the person who nstigated the drive to modernize Janan. The statue was created by Hakuun Motoyama, a sculptor from Kochi prefecture. The maximum overall height of the exhibit is 13.5m with his actual statue height of 5.3m.


